Farletonview Carp Lake - Fly Fishery Rules

Season - Farletonview carp fly fishery is open throughout 12 months of the year, seven days a week - **Except** for approx. 3 weeks over Christmas and New Year - The fishery is closed from 20th December - 8th January inclusive.

Opening Hours - Access to the site is from 8am until sunset or 10pm whichever is earlier. It is the responsibility of anglers to establish the time of sunset on the day, should they plan to stay late.

All anglers must be familiar with the WADAA General Rules and Code of Conduct. See general rules.

Strictly artificial fly only. Loose feed may be used, but only on the carp lake.

Barbless flies MUST be used.

Conventional fly rod, reel and line must be used. No bubble floats.

Unhooking mats MUST be used. They need to be wet before the carp is placed on it.

No keepnets allowed.

Adequate sized landing nets must be used.

You must **not** use landing nets with knotted mesh (National byelaw).

All fish must be carefully returned to the lake.

Some carp weigh in excess of 10lbs, so please use sufficiently strong leaders; at least 8lbs breaking strain.

No fish to be transferred between the lakes without permission from the club.

No fishing on the carp lake on the bank between the two lakes, due to back cast safety.

The pellet feeder must not be tampered with.

Wading is prohibited.

CATCH RETURNS MUST BE COMPLETED, for both the carp and trout lakes (Two returns if you fish on both in one visit).
